
What is EBSCOhost eBook?

EBSCOhost eBooks are selected perpetual electronic books purchased by UTB Library that can be accessed online. This guide will demonstrate how to access these purchased eBooks from off-campus. Currently, the library has procured over 100 titles, with additional acquisitions anticipated.



1. First-time applicants need to be on campus and connected to any of UTB network:




2. Go to the UTB Library website **OR** key in the link below:



3. Click **"E-Resources"** on the top menu bar




4. Scroll down. Look and click the **EBSCOhost** icon as shown below:








6. At the top-right corner of the page, click **"MyEBSCO"**



7. Click **"Create an account"**:




8. Click **"Sign up"** and create your account by filling in the empty fields:


